Who is eligible for the state convention?

Anyone who votes in the March 2 Republican primary election in Williamson County. It is not required to attend the county convention in order to be elected as a delegate/alternate to the state convention.

How much are Party Dues?

Dues are \$25 family / \$15 individual per year, and can be mailed payable to WCRP, PO Box 393, Round Rock, TX 78680. Dues for prior years will also be gladly accepted.

Who should fill out this application?

Everyone who wants to be considered for the state convention. Even if you are well-known as a hard worker and every committee member knows you, they still need to know who is available and interested in going to the convention in June.

How should the application be turned in?

Should alternate delegates attend the state convention? YES! It is a longstanding practice in Williamson County to make sure every alternate delegate has an opportunity to be seated as a delegate at some point during the convention and fully participate in the proceedings. Alternate delegates have the same access to receptions, exhibits, and other activities. They do, however, have a separate seating area for caucuses and the general sessions.

Who should interview in person?

New volunteers are encouraged to appear in person before the nominations committee. This generally means anyone who did not attend the 2008 county or state convention from Williamson County. Also, anyone who was nominated as a delegate in 2008 but did not attend the convention should strongly consider meeting with the nominations committee.

The temporary nominations committee will be conducting interviews before the county convention. Please consult the web page or contact the committee chairman, Hal Talton, for information about these meetings. Those new to the Williamson County Republican Party are strongly encouraged to meet with the nominations committee before the county convention.

Once the Permanent Nominations Committee is approved at the County Convention, an announcement will be made as to where the committee will meet. There will be a very limited amount of time for interviews at the county convention.
